## THE SCRIPTURES

The Bible is the inspired Word of God, and thus is both inerrant and infallible. The Bible is the sole and complete authority for the believer in all matters of faith and practice. The Bible has been preserved by God for us today. 2 Tim. 3:16–17; 2 Pet. 1:21; Matt. 5:18; 1 Cor. 2:13




# **OUR MISSION FIELD**

### MEXICO

### CULTURE

- The people of Mexico are proud of their native heritage; each region has its own traditions and celebrations that have preserved ancient ancestral customs.
- Family is a very important part of Mexican culture, with parents generally being respected and loyalty to the family being paramount.
- Mexico is a very superstitious country. While some superstitions are common to American culture—like making a wish when blowing out candles—they are taken much more seriously by many people in Mexico, even Christians.
- Historically, Mexico has been a religious country and the second most Catholic nation. However, religion does not hold as much respect or importance among the newer generations.

## THE NEED

- Need to Proclaim the True Gospel: Because Catholicism is so prevalent, there is a great need to proclaim the true Gospel that our salvation is by faith alone (Ephesians 2:8-9).
- A Need for Biblical Clarity: There is a critical need to guide people toward a biblical understanding of the Holy Spirit and true worship (John 4:24)
- A Need for Personal Faith: There is an urgent need to challenge the temptation to rely on a cultural religion, calling people to move toward a personal relationship with God (John 14:6).
- A Need for Discipleship: There is a significant need for intentional discipleship to combat the widespread confusion of doctrine and build a strong, biblically-grounded faith (John 8:31-32)
